### Outcomes in 2022 – GCSE and Post-16

- Many of our students in Year 11 and Year 13 made exceptional progress.
- Attainment is consistently significantly above national averages. Our Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5 results over time compare favourably to schools in the local authorities we serve: Barnet, Enfield and Haringey.
- Two sixth form students start at University of Oxford this autumn.
- All students moving on to the next step of their education, apprenticeship or training.

The 7-year journey for our students is a great experience where they feel cared for at every point.

Our school motto is '**Ever to Excel**'; for our ethos, this means the following: *our students always try their best and never give up knowing that they will be nurtured and supported to achieve their ambitions.*
